Horst Fischer. You may not know the sound of his name. But you know the sound of his music. He was a legend, touring around the world with his „Golden Trumpet“. To preserve his legacy, Woodstock Music decided to invite world famous trumpet players to revive some of his most famous pieces of music. Combined with the rich sound of a Big Band this record will be one to remember.

Introducing “Woodstock Allstar Band”

Since 2017, the Woodstock Allstar Band has stood for powerful wind instruments from the ranks of international orchestras and bands. After the collaboration with James Morrison in 2017, the sensational appearance with "The Baseballs" in 2018, a wild bluegrass show with "Steve'n'Seagulls" and a "Tribute to James Last" in 2019, the first record is on its way. The Woodstock Allstar Band dedicates a "Tribute to Horst Fischer" to the forgotten German trumpet legend Horst Fischer.

Horst Fischer: a legend of the past

He was like no one. A legend among trumpeters. Horst Fischer made it to the top of the charts and sold more than 1 million records. Born 1930 near Chemnitz, he was more than an ordinary trumpet player. Forever known for his extraordinary cadences, his incredible art of playing and his penchant for high notes. Above all, he made a name for himself with his final cadences in "Ciribiribin" up to f3 or in Erwin Lehn's "Western Blues". His golden age was the 50s and 60s. He was celebrated worldwide and engaged by well-known orchestras.

A life full of musical highs, which, however, came to a sad end. The musician was forgotten by the music world and died in 1986 impoverished and drawn by alcohol. Now it's time to pay tribute to Horst "Hackl" Fischer and his Magic Trumpet. And who could do that better than the musicians of the Woodstock Allstar Band?

Rich sound and outstanding soloists

The Woodstock Allstar Band album is refined by a selection of musicians who complement the legendary tracks as soloists.

- **Allen Vizzutti (USA)**
Allen has visited 70 countries and every state in the union to perform with a rainbow of artists and ensembles as both a classical and jazz artist.
- **Bobby Shew (USA)**
Booby formed his professional career from local clubs to Las Vegas and a Grammy Nomination. Leading to being one of the biggest role model and teacher for trumpet players worldwide.
- **Thomas Gansch (AT)**
Thomas is not only one of the most versatile trumpeters of his generation, but also an entertainer through and through, who always makes jokes, but never loses sight of the music.



- **Rashawn Ross (USA)**
Although jazz is a huge influence, Rashawn has compiled a large résumé with artists in many different genres ranging from funk, jazz, rock, hip hop, r&b, soul, pop, latin and country.
- **Eric Miyashiro (USA/JPN)**
Born and raised in Hawaii to a musical family, Eric is now one of the most in demand soloist/clinician in the world, now based in Japan.
- **Tero Lindberg (FIN)**
One of Finland's leading trumpet players, Tero can be heard on numerous recordings and tours by foremost Finnish artists as well as in many TV programmes in Finland.
- **Aneel Soomary (UK/AT)**
The Londoner Aneel Soomary has been living as a freelance musician in Vienna for ten years, where he is involved with the United Stages, among others.
